2. Graduation Requirements

*Total Hours required	124 hours (must include 45 hours of 3/4000-level courses)
General Education	50-53 hours
Major Core Courses	24 hours (Corrections) 6 hours (Internship) 9 hours (Criminal Justice)
Additional Requirements	3 hours (Social Statistics)
Free Electives	30 hours
3. *I* grade must be made up within one year (student should not re-enroll in courses during that year). At end of one year if *I* has not been changed, it becomes a permanent *I* and student must re-enroll in course to receive credit.
4. Only Oklahoma Associate of Arts and Associate of Science degrees will automatically clear general education requirements (not out-of-state associate degrees or Associate of Applied Science degrees).
5. Required assessment exam taken prior to graduation.
6. Requests for course substitutions must be approved by Department Chair and Dean of Arts & Sciences prior to enrollment.

*Basic skills (zero-level) courses, activity courses (swimming, etc.), and performance courses (band, choir, etc.) do not count toward graduation (effective Fall 1994).
