PUBLIC DISCLOSURE FOR Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) HEERF II GRANTS TO STUDENTS

Section 314(a)(1)(a)(4)

Langston University fully expended all funds as of August 15, 2021. The numbers below are the final required reporting and cover all HEERF fund expenditures for Section 314(a)(1)(a)(4) Student Portion funds.

- Langston University signed and returned to the Department of Education the Certification and Agreement for **CARES Act HIGHER EDUCATION EMERGENCY RELIEF FUND (HEERF II)**. Langston University used funds received under Section 314(a)(1)(a)(4) for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
- Langston University received \$1,541,221.00 under Section 314(a)(1)(a)(4) of the CRRSAA HEERF II from the Department of Education pursuant to the Certification and Agreement.
- Langston University distributed \$1,541,221.00 in emergency grants under Section 314(a)(1)(a)(4) of the CRRSAA HEERF II.
- There are an estimated 1,931 students at Langston University eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 314(a)(1)(a)(4) of the CRRSAA HEERF II.
- 1,113 students received emergency grants under Section 314(a)(1)(a)(4) of the CRRSAA HEERF II.
- Langston University invited students to complete an online application for the Langston University CRRSAA HEERF II Grant. On the application, made available on March 10, 2021, students verified they had expenses related to any component of their cost of attendance or emergency costs due to COVID-19, such as tuition, food, housing, healthcare (including mental health), or childcare. Students also submitted an estimate of the immediate amount needed.

- Individual award amounts were determined by considering the amount of estimated immediate need reported by the student on the application. Students with exceptional financial needs, such as those who receive Pell Grants, were given priority consideration.
- A campus-wide online seminar was held to introduce the grant opportunity on March 8, 2021. Campus-wide emails were sent to all students, faculty, and staff beginning on March 10, 2021, with reminders sent twice weekly through March 31, 2021, notifying them of the availability of the emergency grants under Section 314(a)(1)(a)(4) of the CRRSAA Act HEERF II and provided instructions on how to complete and submit the application.
