Reminders:

1. Graduation Requirements: Total Hours: 62 hours
2. *I* grade must be made up within one year (student should not re-enroll in course during that year). At end of one year if *I* has not been changed, it becomes a permanent *I* and student must re-enroll in course to receive credit.
3. Only Oklahoma Associate of Arts and Associate of Science degrees will automatically clear general education requirements (not out-of-state associate degrees or Associate of Applied Science degrees).
4. Basic skills (zero-level) courses, activity courses (swimming, etc.), and performance courses (band, choir, etc.) do not count toward graduation (effective Fall 1994).
5. Students are advised to follow plan of study, as courses are offered once per year.
