Accounting

Program Overview

The Bachelor of Science degree with a major in Accounting is designed to provide students with a broad overview of accounting theory and practice while also allowing students to gain in-depth knowledge in an area of their choice such as taxes, financial accounting, manufacturing accounting, and governmental accounting.

LU-Tulsa accounting graduates work for public accounting firms, manufacturing and service firms, governmental, and non-profit institutions ranging in size from a few employees to those with International operations.

LU-Tulsa graduates who aspire to pass the Certified Public Accounting (CPA) exam have experienced a success rate far greater than the national average. While only 10-15% of CPA candidates pass the exam on their first attempt, LU-Tulsa graduates have traditionally had a successful rate of 30-40%. Since 1986, four LU-Tulsa alumni have earned the highest score on the CPA exam. Two alumni have earned the 2nd highest and two alumni have earned the 3rd highest score.

Admissions Requirements

- Completed Admission Application from Langston University-Tulsa
- □ A minimum of 48 transferable college credit hours
- □ A minimum 2.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- □ All official transcripts from previous college(s)
- With an Associate of Arts and an Associate of Science degree from an Oklahoma college, all general education requirements are completed; Applied Science degrees from some institutions may not be fully articulated

Degree Requirements

- □ 124 credit hours
- □ A maximum of 64 of these hours may be earned at a junior college
- All BBA candidates must complete the general education courses prescribed by Langston University-Tulsa
- 42 hours of common business core courses prescribed by the LU School of Business
- □ A cumulative grade point average of 2.00 or higher is required for graduation
- □ A grade point average of 2.00 or higher is required in the major
- 30 credit hour residency (Must be taken at Langston University)
