## Admissions Requirements

- Completed Admission Application from LU-Tulsa
- A minimum of 48 transferable college credit hours
- A minimum 2.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- All official transcripts from previous college(s)
*With an Associate of Arts and an Associate of
Science degree from an Oklahoma college, all general education requirements are completed;
Applied Science degrees are not fully articulated.


## Degree Requirements

- 124 credit hours
- A maximum of 64 of these hours may be earned at a junior college
- All BBA candidates must complete the general education courses prescribed by LU-Tulsa
- 42 hours of common business core courses prescribed by the LU School of Business
- A cumulative grade point average of 2.00 or higher is required for graduation
- 30 credit hour residency (Must be taken at Langston University)
