

Fall 2019 Headcount Enrollment Compared to Fall 2018



Fall 2019 Headcount Enrollment by Classification and Full-Time/Part-Time Status







Percentage of Fall 2019 Age Distribution Compared to Fall 2018



Fall 2019 Age Distribution Analysis












