Program Overview

The Bachelor of Arts in Psychology introduces theories and methods of intervention at the individual, group, family, and urban community levels. The program provides the student with a level of understanding and competencies, preparing him/her to interact with other people.

The student pursuing a degree in psychology should be able to conduct and evaluate research, particularly research that is relevant to urban and clinical concerns and develop clinical skills that are often prerequisite for medical, community, and mental health programs. The degree also prepares students for counseling and graduate school requirements in various fields of psychology. Internships in psychology direct the student toward several areas of emphasis and interest.

Admissions Requirements

- ❑ Completed Admission Application from Langston University-Tulsa
- ❑ A minimum of 48 transferable college credit hours
- ❑ A minimum 2.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- ❑ All official transcripts from previous college(s)
- ❑ With an Associate of Arts and an Associate of Science degree from an Oklahoma college, all general education requirements are completed; Applied Science degrees from some institutions may not be fully articulated

Degree Requirements

- ❑ 124 credit hours
- ❑ A maximum of 64 of these hours may be earned at a junior college
- ❑ Minimum of 45 hours of upper division (3000-4000 level)
- ❑ 30 credit hour residency (Must be taken at Langston University)
- ❑ Must be enrolled at Langston University-Tulsa the semester of intended graduation
- ❑ Grades of "C" or better are required in major courses
