Langston University looks forward to welcoming you to campus for Spring 2024! We are here to help. Please use the information below as a guide for your move-in day experience.

HOUSING CHECK-IN PROCESS

- > Step 1: All Students should visit the I.W. Young Auditorium to confirm that all move-in requirements have been met.
 - All students should be prepared to show photo identification (Langston University ID or government issued ID) to confirm identity.
 - Any outstanding requirements must be addressed with the appropriate office such as Financial Aid, Office of the Registrar, or Student and Employee Services.
 - Advisors are available to assist with enrollment. Upperclassmen will visit with their faculty advisor. Incoming students and returning students who have earned less than 40 credit hours should visit with a University College advisor located on the second floor of University Women.
 - ENROLLMENT REQUIRED. Individuals who report to campus and are not enrolled will not be permitted to move-in.
- > Step 2: Once all requirements are met, students will proceed to the stage within I. W. Young Auditorium.
 - · Our Housing staff will assist in confirming the housing assignment of each student.
 - · Before leaving I. W. Young Auditorium, students will complete the following steps with Housing:
 - o Activate your meal plan
 - o Confirm your housing reservation
- > Step 3: Students should proceed to their assigned housing clubhouse and complete these steps:
 - Sign for responsibility of Community Standards
 - Complete Emergency Contact Form
 - Complete Room Condition Form
 - o A key to the room assignment will be given once all documents are completed.
